About SSAC

South Shore Art Center's mission is to enrich the communities south of Boston by engaging artists and by fostering an understanding and appreciation of the visual arts through exhibitions and education.

Founded in 1955, South Shore Art Center (SSAC) grew from a chance meeting in Cohasset Common when Helen Howe Vosoff, President of the then newlyformed South Shore Music Circus, stumbled upon artists Tom Lucas and MacIvor Reddie painting en plein air. The three embarked on a long conversation about the need for a local art center. Soon thereafter they organized an active group of similarly-minded individuals. Within one year, they had established art classes, registered 110 students and attracted 100



members to their cause. They celebrated with a community arts festival at the scene of the inspiration: Cohasset Common. Art was everywhere – propped on easels and pinned



on clotheslines strung from trees. The excitement of so much talent in one small place over one short weekend inspired an annual event that has grown in scale and scope to become one of the mostanticipated festivals of the region.

And here we are celebrating our 64th annual Arts Festival! Thank you for helping us make history by participating in this wonderful art immersion.

Like our Festival, SSAC has grown in vitality, as a place where creativity, inquiry and innovation converge regularly through arts education; exhibitions; cultural events; key community partner-ships; and investment in local artists. Now more than 1,000 members strong, our geographic reach extends from our Cohasset beginnings to the 45 communities south of Boston; and we represent a key anchor for the region's vibrant

and thriving art community. Each year, SSAC welcomes nearly 20,000 individuals – of all ages, abilities and incomes – to diverse and exciting visual arts experiences held in our facility and at satellite sites throughout the area.

SSAC launched **FESTIVAL ART STARS** in 2012 to engage local teens in invitational collaborative art projects, designed for public installation. The program, which unfolds over six Saturdays, partners teens with several **SSAC** faculty members on concept development, design, construction and critique of a variety of art projects. Participating students must be nominated by their art teacher, and must commit to being fully present for the six-week immersive work period.

The results are stunning! The Art Center's west-facing exterior wall is lined with large-scale murals completed by our **FESTIVAL ART STARS**, each one showcasing the immense creative talent and potential of teen artists and the impact of visual arts on beautifying the public domain. See for yourself the next time you travel east on Pleasant Street in Cohasset or when you pass the Art Center on the commuter line!

This year's **FESTIVAL ART STARS** responded to the theme "**Visual Puns**" by designing and developing a series of three-dimensional sculptures comprised of corrugated cardboard. (See if you can guess the prompts for the works featured here!) The completed works will debut on the Cohasset Common during the annual Art Festival and will be subsequently installed in SSAC's sculpture garden.

This innovative program has introduced thousands of students to professional local artists working in a diverse array of media: painting, printmaking, book making, sculpture and more. Students visit our art center for 2 hours, meet with the artist, and creation their own masterpieces in the artist's medium to take home.



This program is made possible by the hard work of our dedicated team of Docents: Lisa Alexander, Cam Chamberlin, Jane Hale, Jane Johnson, Lynne Johnson, Esther Maschio, Tania McCann, Marlene Tabor, and Amanda Zini. On Wednesday mornings, throughout the school year, Docents engage approximately 50 students in enriching art making and educational activities.



In the Fall of 2019, we welcome a new talent, **Jess Hurley Scott**, as our Artist in Residence. She is a contemporary painter of land and seascapes. 






• The "Student Artist of the Year" is a need-based scholarship for a local middle or high school student demonstrating commitment to and talent in the visual arts. Candidates for this scholarship should be nominated by a member of the SSAC faculty or by an art instructor at an area school. Awardees will receive a certificate valued for one free SSAC art class (up to a \$250 value).
