## **Exhibition Proposal Form**

**3 copies of the Curator/Organizer's Statement of Concept** (1–3 pages total). The statement must begin with a one-paragraph summary of the curatorial intention of the show and should address how each of the artist's work relates to the central concept.

**Resumes and References:** Include one copy each of the resumes, biographies, artist statements of the curator(s) and each of the participating artists. Curators must also submit contact information for three professional or academic references.

**3 Copies of the Image List** Slides OR digital submissions. Publications are also helpful as supporting information. Image lists are available for download from our website. The image list must correlate exactly with the slides or digital images The list must include (for each work):

- Artist's Name
- Title of work
- Medium
- Dimensions

- Image Number
- Date
- 'A' (for actual work to be exhibited) OR
- 'R' (for representative of work to be exhibited)
- Price (Retail) SSAC receives 40% of the purchase price.

Inclusion of images of 'actual' work is encouraged. Inclusion of only 'representative' work may affect the committee's decision. Artists whose images have been submitted must have agreed to participate prior to submission.

### IMAGE REQUIREMENTS: Digital images on CD's and/or slides are acceptable.

**Digital Images:** A maximum of 80 images per proposal will be accepted/reviewed. Please submit images on a CD labeled with the curator's name and the title of the proposed exhibit. This CD must be viewable both on MAC and PC. Images on CD should be labeled with the artist's last name first, then 01, 02, 03, etc. (**for example: lastname\_01**) This numbered list must correlate exactly with the image list. Image format must be jpeg, 300 dpi, max vertical size of 8 inches or max horizontal size of 10 inches.

# CALL FOR PROPOSALS:

The South Shore Art Center is a non-profit organization whose mission is to enrich the communities south of Boston by fostering an understanding and appreciation of the visual arts through exhibitions and education. SSAC invites interested artists/curators to submit proposals for exhibitions to be scheduled in the Bancroft Gallery for 2011/2012. Artists/Curators may propose exhibitions consisting of one medium or several media, and are encouraged to consider including performance, music, poetry or related arts. Curators who are artists themselves may include their work in the exhibition, but it should not be the central focus. Exhibitions generally run 6 weeks.

# **GUIDELINES FOR PROPOSALS:**

1. Description of the exhibition with a statement of the underlying concept is required. The committee will look for a coherent central theme in the proposal. Since a major focus of the SSAC's mission is educational, we encourage proposals to include panel discussions, gallery talks and related educational presentations.

- 2. Current resumes of the curator and/or artists should accompany the proposal.
- 3. Slides/Digital images must accompany the proposal.

A. **CURATED EXHIBITIONS:** The curator should select a group of artists and submit 3–5 slides/images per artist of recent work (within 3 years) representative of the theme and focus of the exhibition. The curator will be responsible for submitting the proposal, organizing the exhibition and coordinating all contractual activities with the SSAC.

B. **GROUP EXHIBITIONS:** A group wishing to exhibit together must select a designated curator as above. In some cases, the committee may make curatorial suggestions.

## **Art Sales:**

South Shore Art Center receives 40% of the purchase price.

## The Art Center provides:

- printing and postage of a postcard invitation
- advertisements and listings in Art New England and Artscope
- gallery signage
- exhibition installation

## The Art Center does not provide (or pay for):

- transportation of artwork to or from SSAC
- unusual installation construction

## Criteria

• Quality of the work to be shown

### • Clarity, and power of the exhibition concept

Exhibitions should have an articulate central idea convincingly presented by the work shown.

# A Statement of Concept expressing the central idea should accompany the proposal.

## Capability of the curator to carry out the project

This includes assuring timely delivery/pickup of artwork, press materials and artist statements.

### Review of Applications

Applications are reviewed by a committee of professional artists, educators, and SSAC staff. The committee reviews the application and support materials for the quality of work, educational potential, and clarity. A studio visit may follow.


