## South Shore Art Center Announces Fall Exhibition *Liminal Spaces*Opening Friday September 10

Cohasset, MA -- South Shore Art Center is mounting a Bancroft Gallery exhibition entitled *Liminal Spaces* representing the work of five contemporary artists whose art pushes boundaries while exploring today's rapidly changing world in which boundaries—geographical, political, personal, political and psychological—are constantly being challenged, erased and rewritten. *Liminal Spaces* opens with a reception on Friday, September 10 at 6 pm and continues through October 24, 2010.

Artists Michele L'Heureux, Helen Popinchalk, Lauren Scanlon, Tom Shields and Elizabeth Tomasetti each explore "liminal spaces" from a unique perspective, but with a shared fascination for the discovery and transformation in such spaces. The artists' work ranges from Tom Shields' free standing and wall sculptures constructed from old furniture and found objects to Helen Popinchalk's layered printmaking and Lauren Scanlon's paintings inspired by the roles of monsters and heroes in common social narratives. Michele L'Heureux's paintings and three-dimensional pieces reference the process of discarding, reviving and recreating our identities and Elizabeth Tomasetti's paintings and prints address the limits and confines of individuals' personal space.

During the exhibition, the Dillon Gallery will feature *New Constructs*, work of Gallery Artists Virginia Green, Andrea Kemler, Jeanne McKenna, Mary Taylor and Jeanne Wiley; the Art Center's Faculty Feature will showcase the work of drawing and painting instructor Evelina Brozgul.

Liminal Spaces opens at South Shore Art Center on Friday, September 10 with an opening reception from 6 to 8 pm. Reception is free and open to the public. Gallery hours are Monday through Saturday, 10-4 and Sunday, 12-4, 119 Ripley Road, Cohasset, MA 02025.
