General sewing supplies

Fabric scissors: You should have a pair of scissors devoted to just cutting fabric, paper dulls scissors very quickly. The best scissors for sewing will have a flat side. <http://www.joann.com/sullivans-10-titanium-dressmaker-scissors-purple-green/14789077.html>

Thread cutting scissors: Any pair of small sharp scissors for trimming thread. <http://www.joann.com/dmc-peacock-embroidery-scissors-4in/2160208.html>

Seam Ripper: You WILL make mistakes. The easiest way to fix mistakes is with a seam ripper <http://www.joann.com/prym-dritz-deluxe-seam-ripper/1029305.html>

Projects

Project 1: Tote Bag – quilting weight cotton. NO CANVAS.

1 yard bag exterior
½ yard bag interior

Project 2: Zippered Pillow Cover – quilting weight or upholstery weigh, be careful of fabric that easily frays. Purchase extra fabric if you need to accommodate for images on fabric.

Fabric purchase will depend on pillow size.

16” or smaller pillow: ½ yard of fabric & 12” zipper

18” or larger: your fabric purchase needs to be at least 1 inch larger than your pillow. 12” zipper or larger if your pillow is especially large.

Project 3: Zippered Box Pouch – quilting weight cotton

you may have enough scraps from your tote bag

2 Fat Quarters Or ½ yard cuts.

8” zipper

Instructor will supply interfacing

If time permits, we will work on a 4th project, to be determined in class.
