http://www.lowellquiltfestival.org/ for more information. Ruthe **Sholler** received a Merit for Excellence award for a small palette knife painting of Powder Point, Duxbury. It was featured in an exhibit called Art Focus 2009, at the Art League of Bonita Springs, Florida. This show encompasses artists from the entire Southwest Florida Council. Eight of Ruthe's works were also featured in On Tray Magazine, a journal for good food and entertainment, published in Braintree, MA. Thirteen of Nancy Colella's paintings have been acquired by the Dana Farber Cancer Institute. They will be installed at the new Dana-Farber Brigham and Women's South Shore Hospital Cancer Center scheduled to open in Weymouth on October 5, 2009. Lilly Cleveland will be exhibiting new works in watercolor and mixed media at the Thomas Crane Public Library in Quincy from November 2-30. Lilly will host a gallery talk and demo for her show Watercolor and Beyond and will serve light refreshments on Thursday, November 12, 5:30-7:30 pm. Joan Brancale was accepted to attend an artist retreat at the summer island home of late artist Fairfield Porter. Since 1993, Porter's niece, California artist Anina P. Fuller, has organized a group of twelve people: artists, photographers and poets to draw inspiration from the island and each other. Gallery Artists took top honors at the North River Arts Festival in Marshfield over Memorial Day Weekend. Judy Rossman won first place in sculpture and an honorable mention in Drawing; Peggy Roth Major received Best in Show for her photograph *Moonset on Hatherly* as well as The Linda Movessian Memorial Award for Humor for Tess and an Honorable Mention in Black & White Photography, for Make Mom Happy. Nancy Sargent Howell won first prize in watercolor. Howell will be teaching workshops in Scituate, Kennebunkport, the Adirondacks and Falmouth this summer before heading back to Italy for her twenty-sixth painting trip in September. The Copley Society awarded Dianne Panarelli Miller the first ever Stone, Bush Maloney Fresh Paint Scholarship for her long standing membership. This year's event was Dianne's 19th year participating in the Fresh Paint fundraiser.

Sharon Daly will be featured in a gallery show at the Old Sculpin Gallery on Dock Street in Edgartown, MA from July 25 to August I. She will also be showing at the All Island Art Show on Monday, August 3rd in Oak Bluffs, MA. Sue Dragoo Lembo will be showing her most recent oil paintings in the Chatham Festival of the Arts which runs from August 14-16. **Donna** Rossetti-Bailey, of Marshfield, MA was invited to join the membership of the Academic Artists of America based in Springfield, MA. She has successfully met the difficult qualification of acceptance in two Academic Artists National Juried Shows, 2007 and 2008. Donna's pastel, Last Light at Chandler's Bog was accepted in this year's Academic Artists 59th Annual National Exhibition, which ran from May I-May 29 at American International College in Springfield, MA. The View at Round Pond and Almost Fall at Riverside were accepted into the 5th Annual Northeast National Pastel Exhibition at Arts Center/Old Forge, NY, juried by Maggie Price. The exhibit will be on display June 13-July 12. Bridge Street Reflections has been selected for the Pastel Painters Society of Cape Cod Signature Exhibit at the Cape Cod Museum of Art in Dennis, April 18-June 14. Fellow Gallery Artist Liz Haywood-Sullivan joined Donna at the International Association of Pastel Society's convention in New Mexico. The pastel artists painted under the big sky and visited Albuquerque, Taos and Santa Fe. Their work was among sixty pieces accepted into the IAPS juried show displayed in one of Santa Fe's premier galleries. Beverly Rippel encaustic shoe sculpture was included in The Perfect Fit /Shoes Tell Stories, a national traveling museum show of more than one hundred fun and innovative interpretations on the theme at the Fuller Craft Museum in Brockton, MA. The show will be on view until Jan 3, 2010. Mary **Callahan** has work in the Academic Artists National Exhibition, the Cape Cod Art Association National show, and the upcoming Copley Society's Summer Juried Show. Her work can be seen at the Rockport Art Association Gallery as well as at the North Shore Arts Association.
